The Board of Trustees have now adopted a new code of conduct following community consultation and our last Board meeting which you can view on the school website.



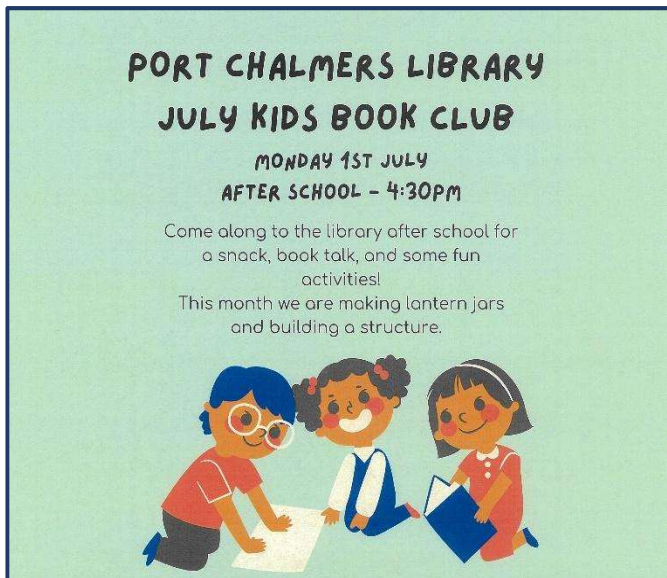

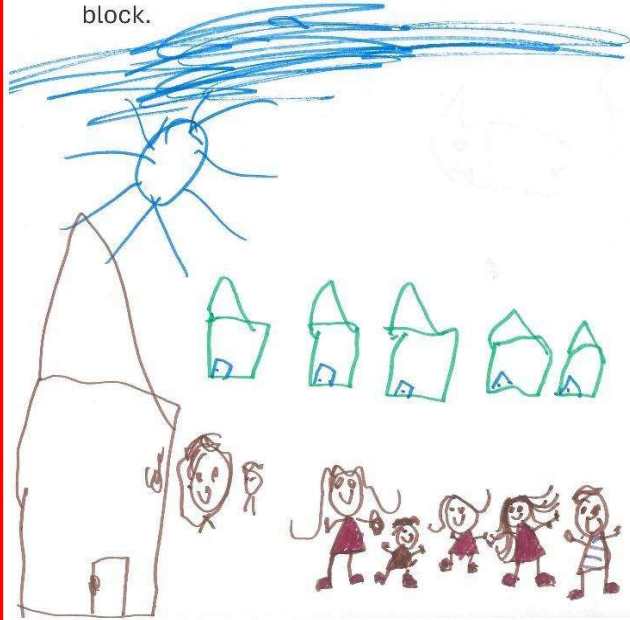
I saw a man eating shark in the water.

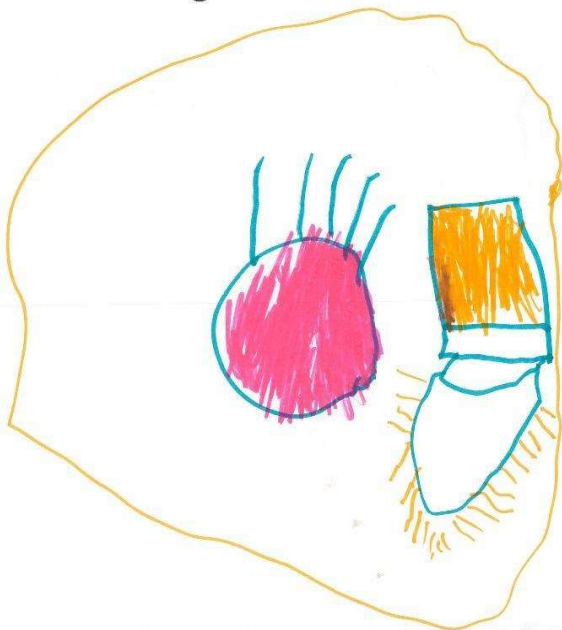
