A working bee is being organised to tidy up and trim some of our trees and clean out gutters. A date will be advised shortly. Would be great to have a number of helpers for this day.


Desks

Sunday 26 May **Holy Trinity Sunday**


Trinity Sunday is the day we celebrate the truth that God is made up of the Father, the Son (Jesus) and the Holy Spirit. The bible tells us that there is only one God but that this God is made up of three parts, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The word we use to describe this 3 in 1 God is "Trinity." That is a word made up of the word "Tri" which mean 3 (eg a tricycle has 3 wheels) and the word "Unity," which means "One" or being unified together.
