WHĀNAU ROOPU

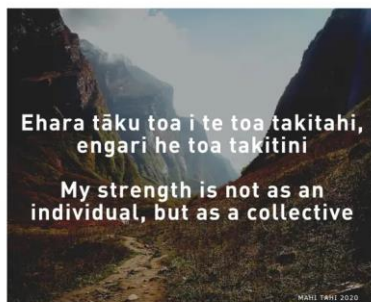
Nā tō rourou, nā taku rourou ka ora ai te iwi.

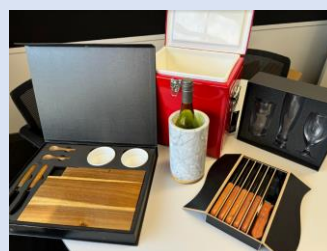
