Super proud of our senior leaders who organized and ran a Quiz night last night to raise funds for the senior teams camp in term 4 to Ranui Farms.

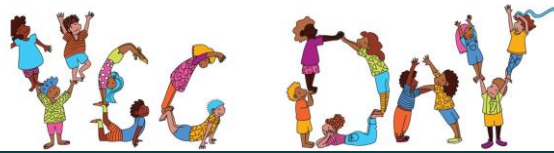
