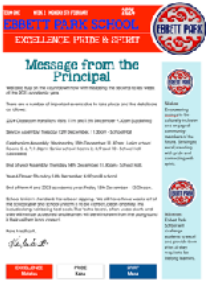

Parking Rules Reminder for Whānau

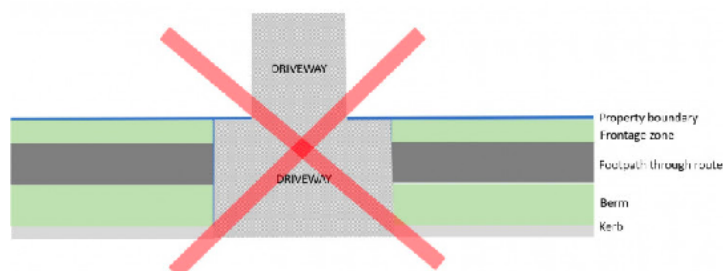
For the safety of our tamariki please follow the parking rules and expectations
