This year Matariki goes ahead as usual, a decent start in the darkness at 7am, some of our wonderful tamariki sharing their knowledge with us all and time to reflect.



### Ballot for Term 4 2024 & Term 1 2025

Te Horo School Out of Zone Enrolment Places Term Four 2024 & Term One 2025 The Te Horo School Board has determined that a total of 5 new entrant places are likely to be available for Year 0 -1 in Term 4 and Term 1 2025 and 5 Year 7 & 8 Places for out-of-zone students for Term 1 2025.

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

For students seeking enrolment within Term 4 2024 & Term 1 2025, the deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is noon on Friday 23rd of August 2024.

Parents of students who live within the home zone and intend enrolling their child at any time during the next year should notify the school at their earliest convenience to assist the school to continue to plan appropriately. Ballot forms are available from the school office office@th.school.nz or call 06 364 3071.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot for out-of-zone places is required for a Term 4 2024 or Term 1 2025 start, it will be held on Monday 26th of August 2024. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.
